

**Explanation in regard to letter grades and other symbols used in this transcript :**

1. **Course number system :**  
(i) 100 to 199 Elementary/Basic courses  
(ii) 200 to 299 Core Under-graduate courses  
(iii) 300 to 399 Advanced under-graduate courses

2. **Significance of grade :**

Percentage of marks	Equivalent letter grade	Meaning	Numerical value of grade in Points
80% of above marks	A	Excellent	5 points
Below 80% but not less than 70% marks	B	Good	4 points
Below 70% but not less than 60% marks	C	Fair	3 points
Below 60% but not less than 50% marks	D	Poor, barely Pass	2 points
Below 50%	E	Failure	1 points

*S=Satisfactory, US=Unsatisfactory, Df=Grade deferred.  
Any courses in which UG student gets 'E' Grade has to be repeated.  
'E' grade (s) are not counted in the computation of O.G.P.A.*

4. **Credit, G. P. A. and Division :**  
One credit=One hour of class study or two to three hours of lab.  
Course points=Numerical value of grade multiplied by credits.  
G. P. A.=Total number of points in courses divided by total number of credit hours offered.  
I Division=O.G.P.A. of 3.5000 or above  
II Division=O. G. P. A. of 3.000 or above but less than 3.500.

5. **Honours Certificate :**  
(i) College Merit certificate-having secured a CGPA of 4.250 or above but less than 4.500 in an academic year,  
(ii) University Merit certificate-having secured a CGPA of 4.500 or above in an academic year.  
(iii) Degree with Honours-having completed degree with an OGPA of 4.250 or above subject to prescribed regulations.

6. **Dropping from the University :**  
(i) Under-graduate students who fail to secure a CGPA of 3.000 at the end of any academic year, irrespective of number of semesters attended are dropped from the University on account of poor academic performance.  
(ii) Any student failing thrice in the same course is also dropped from the University.

7. **The formula adopted by the University for conversion of equivalent percentage of marks is given below :**  
 $Y=60+15X$  where  $X=O.G.P.A-3.000$ ,  $Y=$ Percentage of marks.
