I Eligibility Rules for Regular Students

- 1) A Candidate is declared as having passed the Intermediate Examination if he/she gets a minimum of 30% marks in each paper and 35% in aggregate in one attempt.

Sl. No.	Grade	Range of marks percentage
1	A	Greater than or equal to 75%
2	B	Greater than or equal to 60% and less than 75%
3	C	Greater than or equal to 50% and less than 60%
4	D	Greater than or equal to 35% and less than 50%

II Eligibility Rules for Compartmental Pass

- a) A Candidate is declared as having passed the Intermediate Examination if he/she gets a minimum of 30% marks in each paper and 35% in aggregate in one attempt.
- b) Minimum pass marks for individual papers of first/second year or both under compartmental appearance is 35%.

III Blind, Deaf, Deaf & Dumb candidates are declared as passed 1st / 2nd year, if the candidate gets a minimum of 25% marks in each paper. The award of Grade will be as per usual procedure for Blind candidates.

IV The Deaf, Deaf & Dumb candidates are exempted from appearing one language under Part I or Part II. The Grade will be awarded as usual in consideration of papers appeared.

Note : 'E' - INDICATES EXEMPTION in case of Deaf, Deaf & Dumb candidates, in Part I or Part II.
